



#### **WARMTH**

"We are moving closer to warmth – the little fires in the compound". These words were of great relevance to delegates at the Theosophical Society (TS) International Convention in early January in Varanasi, India.



Orest and I arrived in India to an unexpected, unusual cold snap across northern India. At the venue, in the TS compound in Varanasi, residents who lived in the shanties on the compound were huddled around outdoor fires of burning tree branches in the mornings and evenings. We, along with other delegates, braved the chaos of Indian traffic in the road outside the compound, dodging honking three-wheeler taxis, cows, motor bikes and stray dogs darting every which-way. We were looking for a clothing store which sold thermal underwear. Others sat in the convention sessions with bed rugs around them. Yet others left the compound accommodation for hotels, unable to bear the glistening-damp of the walls of their rooms, recently rendered and unable to dry.

The words about "moving... to warmth" were addressed to the delegates by the International President of the TS, Tim Boyd. He continued on the theme of "warmth" saying that, when "illumined and enflamed by the [ageless wisdom] teaching, those closest to the warming fires of truth attract others". He referred to the ageless wisdom as "a treasure we don't fully understand".

The disciples of Jesus reflected on His teachings on the road to Emmaus saying "Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened the scriptures?" (1) The ability to warm the hearts of others with aspiration, inspiration and illumination is a function of the energies of the Sixth Ray of Devotion and Abstract Idealism, one of the "Seven Forces in Man and in all Nature....the Seven Principal Forces, called rays..."(2)

"It is the Sixth Ray workers, of all the ray types, who have the ardour, earnestness and fiery enthusiasm to render ideas desirable". "Sixth ray people are the outstanding enthusiasts...They become so 'enfired' by their ideals, that they sweep others along irresistibly." (3)



According to Robbins, one of the great abilities of those upon the sixth ray is that they know how to preserve contact with the source of their strength....a beloved source from which animating energy flows...Affirming the best in all things, their optimism is undimmed and undying. In the phenomenal world (the world of many changes) the steadying, orienting influence of sixth ray individuals is extremely valuable. (4)

This view highlights the value of the sixth ray when expressed for the good of all, in contrast to its expression as the fanatical devotion of religious extremists, still evident in today's world. Religious, political, economic, ecological and other systems are foundering around us. World figures and 'pillars of the community' are revealing 'feet of clay'.

In the mass consciousness of humanity across the world, disenchantment, disorientation, depression and disengagement appear to be on the increase. There is a need for world leaders whose vision, passion and commitment to the good of all are able to lift humanity to a new vision and hope.



This is also the service which we can render as esoteric students. Let us take up Tim Boyd's impassioned appeal to be "illumined and enflamed by the teaching". As esoteric (soul-centred) teachers, meditators and practitioners we can strengthen our sixth ray devotion to the teachings and rekindle the warmth that attracts others. Together, may we become "a steadying, orienting influence" within the field of mass consciousness.

Let purpose guide the little wills of men



#### SENTIENCY...STUDENTS AND LEARNING

The level of penetration into the deeper significance of reality when reading an article or book varies greatly over time. If the "Life-stream" is truly entered, lines of relationship become evident and new understandings prevail. This "Life-stream" is the continuity of learning by activating choices so that which has spiritual relevance is focussed upon regularly. This includes daily spiritual practices such as meditation that attune the intuitive function and promote spiritual telepathy. Essentially this "Life-stream" is the soul influence upon the personality and its vehicles.

This gradual soul-personality fusion can become a reality as comprehension becomes readily evident upon re-reading core books. These core books are foundational to our held value and belief patterns of feelings/thoughts. A synthesis develops as cross-referencing becomes a more regular event. This cross-referencing may be due to an alert recognition to key concepts as scanning of resources takes place. There seems to be a rush of three or five hits where the key term "steps out" into visibility. This repetition or recognition helps to establish the concepts or pattern of thoughts so that they can be readily brought to mind or placed into a different context.

There comes a stage beyond the contact and recognition of concepts and themes...moments of impactful vision, original thinking and deep apprehension that leave a being in a state of wonder.

Significance is a higher level of relevance where crucial importance is realised in a moment of revelation. This expansion and penetration into meaning is when a central nodal point (where many lines of relating intersect) is dwelt upon. A larger segment of reality becomes apparent and a lucidity of insight prevails.

Sentiency is gradually unfolding in a natural progression; yet an enhancement takes place through grace because of study, meditation and service. When service involves the presenting of the teachings of the Ageless Wisdom...the qualities of the students may draw forth from the teacher hidden reserves of knowingness...which blossom forth unbidden. The well asked question ...in a true quest for truth... calls forth the response.

We have had mature age enquirers staying for three plus weeks; followed by younger workers who also had that thirst for knowing. They have tested our mettle; this followed five intensive weeks on our first visit to India where we engaged in many casual but profound meetings with interesting people. Altogether this year has so far been a shift in perspectives brought upon by challenging moments. Somehow our teaching, study and discussions have been fruitful!

May the circumstances in your life provide the opportunities for your growth and may love prevail.

#### SOUTHERN LIGHTS CENTRE DIARY NOTES

January found us in India, firstly in Varanasi at the International Convention of the Theosophical Society. We then travelled to Gangtok in Sikkim, Darjeeling and Kalimpong. We had marvellous views of Mt Kanchenjunga in Darjeeling and in a Tibetan Buddhist monastery there we revered a statue of the seated coming World Teacher, Lord Maitreya. We paid our respects at the stupa for Lama Anagarika Govinda and his teacher in another Tibetan Buddhist monastery in Darjeeling and visited the last home of Helena Roerich in Kalimpong. The Capricorn Full Moon was observed at Darjeeling, the ajna centre of planet Earth according to Master Djwhal Khul.



Further pilgrimages were made to the ashram of Sri Aurobindo in Pondicherry and his community at Auroville. We meditated in the room where Ramana Maharshi once gave darshan in his ashram at Tiruvannamalai and climbed Mt Arunachala to his cave. We sat in the presence of Mother Meera during meditation at her school in Madanapalle. We walked in the precincts of the pioneers of theosophy and of the Masters of the Trans-Himalayan Wisdom teachings in the Theosophical Society compound at Adyar in Chennai.

I feel deeply grounded in the cultural roots of the wisdom teachings through the experiences in India. The final five days of our five-week journey were spent in the Bodhi Zendo centre high in the mountains out of Madurai. I found this experience to be exquisite, both for the beauty of the surroundings and for the refinement of the meditations.

On return to Southern Lights Centre we were confronted by a demolished garden around parts of our house, in preparation for painting the house. Our house-sitters were also keen to start a Hugel garden and all is in place now for the planting of vegetables, at the bottom of a bank in front of the house. Two young WWOOFers from Germany are involved with the wood chopping and storing for winter and have helped start the painting process in the last few days. They also helped build a set of stairs down to the Hugel garden, topped with river pebbles.



We recently farewelled a delightful couple in their sixties from the Isle of Wight. They came for three weeks for our teachings and helped in the garden as well as teaching us some very gentle gradations of yoga asanas (Brian, the husband is a Yoga teacher). I enjoyed taking them around the Maori Museum at Okains Bay and they went on a nature cruise on Akaroa Harbour.

The Aquarius and Pisces Full Moon Meditation Retreats were held here with people from Christchurch attending.



We have welcomed several visitors for meals and afternoon teas, including a person who interpreted for the Dalai Lama in Germany. He provided a wonderful opportunity to learn more about the Dalai Lama from close quarters. A Mindfulness group stayed one weekend.

We are looking for a way to rehouse the library. The precious out-of-print books need protection from the moths, dust and temperature changes in the 1885 shepherd's cottage which also has rats in the ceiling. Our versatile builder gave a quote of \$NZ15,000 -\$20,000 for a recycled refrigerated shipping container with its interior refurbished with shelving, including siting and connecting to power and installing a humidifier. This is beyond our means at present and, in the interim, vermin-proofing and adding further insulation to the existing library are being considered.

This is the season for seemingly never-ending supplies of tomatoes from our greenhouse and offers of plums, pears, peaches, apples and marrows from neighbours and friends.

The Akaroa choir (the Tectonic Tones) continues to be a source of fun and inspiration, our latest potluck dinner being in the community centre (the old schoolhouse) at Le Bons Bay after singing in the local church there.

Some of you may currently be in lock-down in your home, town or country until the coronavirus has run its course. I have noted the number of articles about pandemic as an opportunity for people everywhere to reflect more deeply on their lifestyles, to connect with loved ones and enjoy the blessings of silence and stillness. For those on the spiritual path this is an opportunity to build and radiate out inner peace into the global consciousness field. Humanity's 'spring clean' as the northern spring commences?
